Phase 2: July 1, 2021 - June 30, 2023

ACET, Inc. continued coordinating the Pediatric Care Coordination: Community of Practice under a grant funded by the Minnesota Department of Health that was initially started in January of 2020. This program is designed to facilitate communication and collaboration among pediatric care coordinators across Minnesota to better serve children and youth with special health needs (CYSHN).

756 total members, 316 new members since July 1, 2021


• Members joined to learn new information, utilize resources and training, feel part of a community of peers, and share their perspective and experiences with their peers.



QUARTERLY WEBINARS

Quarterly webinars increase knowledge of care coordination promising practices, skills needed for management of care, and access to valuable resources for people who coordinate care for children and youth with special needs and their families.



- **1664** unique registrations for webinars hosted by the Community of Practice, **1325** total participants across the 6 webinars
- Average attendance was 57% of registration
- 1354 non-members registered for webinars
- All webinar survey respondents agreed the information was presented in an easily
 understood way, met the objectives of the webinar, and the materials covered were
 relevant. Almost all (98%) strongly agreed or agreed the information presented
 increased their knowledge of the topic.
